## Golf Course News

The golf course is really great condition at this time. After fertilization, the fairways are growing nicely.

I ask all of you to help improve the course conditions by replacing divots with sand in the golf carts and repairing ball marks on the greens. If there are any unfixed marks near yours or while you are waiting, please repair any that you can. This will tremendously improve the putting conditions.

Here are a few tips to help speed-up play during a typical round of golf:

\*Be ready to hit when it is your turn. Through the green don't wait until it is your turn to hit before checking your yardage. On the green, read your putt while the other players in your group are putting.

\*Watch your shot (and playing partner's shots) until the ball looks to be at rest. Then pick out a reference

point (tree, stake, plant, etc...) so you can find each other's golf balls faster and ultimately speed-up play.

\*Finally, if players behind you catch your group, please let them play through (no matter how many in the group).
