We would like ask all of you to keep the golf carts out of the fairway at all times. This will promote a better hitting surface and a quicker-and-thicker grow-in this spring. Cutting across the fairway four or five times a hole is just as bad as driving up the fairway the entire way.

For those members who have their respective dues withdrawn from a debit/credit card, please check the expiration date to make sure Island Green has up-to-date card information.

Please remember to fix ball marks on the greens. There are

many greens with large amounts of ball marks on them. The greens do not heal as quickly as they do in the summer so please do your part and fix your mark and one more. This will tremendously improve the condition of the greens.
